 - ADM: 160
 - Attendance: 86%
 - Meetings with families regarding attendance/retention have made a big difference in those students' daily attendance
 - MCAs began in April 10th, testing is going well
 - Learning Lab is going very well. Students have been participating in lots of great activities
 - April 14th PD went well, Northern Clay came and staff completed an online course of their choice thru BER
 - Open positions for next year are posted
 - Raise \$1,400.00 from the Spaghetti dinner
 - The contract with 3D Response has been signed, John Hubener is working on grants for the project and the safety assessment has been scheduled for the 19th at 5:30.
 - Discussed playground status and need for a conversation the church
